

Terms & Conditions 2017 - English

GENERAL CATEGORY

All kind of works

- 1__ Films from overseas can participate in BccN 2017, whether full-length, medium-length or short films. Films must have been shot in 2016 or 2017 and be licensed under Creative Commons or any other free license.

- 2__ Submission deadline: **April 30th 2017**
- 3__ **Submission is free.** Candidates must send an email to programacion@bccn.cc and include an hyperlink to watch the film in either a private or public way. The email should provide information regarding the film production, distribution or exhibition related to the use of the Creative Commons license.
The Organization will also appreciate the film being subtitled in Spanish and/or English

SELECTION AND AWARDS

- 4__ The programming committee will choose the names of the shortlisted films to be announced on the Festival website at the beginning of May
- 5__ The works will be screened on BccN 2017, between June 7th and 11th in MACBA Barcelona Museum of Contemporary Art. The Organization will seek to bring to Barcelona the authors of the selected works during the Festival
- 6__ The works may also have the possibility, among another special works, to become part of and be distributed by the CCWorld-copy festivals network, spread across more than 10 countries like Spain, Colombia, Peru, Mexico, Rumania, etc

MADE IN BCN CATEGORY

Shortfilms new catalan authorship

- 1__ Shortfilms from young directors from Catalonia can participate in the category *Made in BCN*. Films must have been shot in 2016 or 2017, last less than 15 minutes and be licensed under Creative Commons or any other free license.

- 2__ Submission deadline: **April 30th 2017**
- 3__ **Submission is free.** Candidates must send an email to programacion@bccn.cc and include an hyperlink to watch the film in either a private or public way or using the platform www.movi-beta.com

SELECTION AND AWARDS

- 4__ The programming committee will choose the names of the shortlisted films to be announced on the Festival website before the festival. The works will be screened at MACBA and candidates will aim for:

MoviBeta Award: voted by a jury, it consists in an online film distribution across 50 Film festivals of the Movibeta platform during one year (valued at 500 eur)

CCWorld Award voted by the audience, it consist in the distribution of the film in the Creative Commons World-copy festivals network.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREEMENT

- 5__ The Festival BccN will respect the uses permitted depending on the CC licence of every film. The creators will send any material required by the organization in order to carry out the screenings properly.
- 6__ By submitting your film to BccN 2017 you confirm that you have read and understood the above-mentioned terms and conditions and thus agree to abide by them
